Vertical Market Software's Inventory module is designed to provide an efficient method of organizing and controlling product sold from one main warehouse, remote warehouses, over-the-counter retail sales, or from a service vehicle. Inventory receipts, transfers from location to location, and issues to jobs are accomplished with minimum effort. Inventory turn-over reporting helps in reducing inventory levels, in addition to improving inventory ordering procedures and ensuring adequate stock is on hand during times of historically high demand. With the Inventory module you are able to quickly determine profitable stock.

Some of the benefits of the Inventory module:

- 20 character alphanumeric item number.
- Up to 999 additional lines of description per item.
- Manufacturers part number maintained per item.
- Bar-coding capable, both scanning and printing.
- Item number may be cross referenced to a substitute part.
- Ability to track serial number for items in stock and items sold.
- Ability to establish kits, made up of numerous items.
- Maintains product inventory for up to 9999 warehouse (or truck locations) with ability to store item cost and price by location.
- Ability to copy items from one location to another automatically, greatly reducing set-up time.
- Ability to use bin and aisle location by item, and warehouse.
- Ability to group items by category.
- Inventory history, including detail of sales and receipts, can be maintained as long as needed.
- Portable data collection units for physical inventory counts.
- Ability to look up items by part number, description, or user defined look-up parameters. These inventory look-up features are available in any VMS application which accesses inventory.
- Ability to transfer items from one location to another, issue items to jobs or service tickets, scrap items, and track RMA's in and out.
- Ability to view gross profit for items by vendor or department, with options available when printing.
- Ability to attach notes, pictures, email and other documents to items.
- Ability to view reports.
- Numerous pricing methods:
 - Up to six list prices per item.
 - Mark from list (up to six levels).
 - Mark up from cost (up to six levels).
 - Quantity Pricing (up to six levels).
 - Special item (contract) pricing by customer.
 - Promotional pricing by item or group of items for a given period.
- LIFO, FIFO, average, standard, and last cost evaluation methods.
- Ability to quickly reprice or recost one item or a range of items by percentage of dollar amount.
- Stock unit of measure, price unit of measure, and purchase-to-inventory ratio maintained for each item, assisting in the ordering and pricing of items.
- Reorder point, lead time to delivery, economic reorder quantity, quantity on order and allocated and weight per unit maintained for each item.
- Ability to maintain a cycle code by item to identify the period in which an item is counted. A worksheet may be printed to aid in physical count process. Quantity adjustments may be made by item.
- Ability to print price lists and catalogues.
- Ability to view inventory sales trends and inventory item usage under numerous methods.
